NOTICE TO SUBCONTRACTORS, MATERIAL SUPPLIERS AND WORKERS

The City of Shafter is actively soliciting bids from prospective subcontractors or materials suppliers whose businesses qualify as Section 3 Business Concerns, as well as individuals who qualify as Section 3 Workers or Section 3 Targeted Workers in connection with the **City of Shafter Library and Learning Center, Chess Garden (CDBG 18.22.1 & 18.23.1)** project to be located in the County of Kern and funded by the HUD.

A Section 3 Business Concern is a business:

- (1) that is 51% or more owned and controlled by low- or very low-income persons; or
- (2) The business is at least 51% owned and controlled by residents who currently live in public housing or Section 8-assisted housing; or
- (3) Over 75% of the labor hours performed for the business over the prior three-month period were performed by Section 3 workers.

A Section 3 Worker is:

- (1) Is a low- or very low-income worker that fell below HUD income limits for the previous or annualized calendar year. Low- and very-low-household income limits may be obtained from: <http://www.huduser.org/portal/datasets/il.html> or through the County of Kern Planning and Natural Resource Department Community Development Division; or
- (2) The worker employed by a Section 3 business concern. (see Section 3 Business Concern).
- (3) The worker is a YouthBuild participant. (YouthBuild is a community-based pre-apprenticeship program administered by the U.S. Department of Labor that provides job training and educational opportunities for at-risk youth ages 16-24 who have previously dropped out of high school.)

A Section 3 Targeted Worker is:

- (1) A worker employed by a Section 3 business concern (defined below), or
- (2) A worker who currently fits or when hired fit at least one of the following categories, as documented within the past five years:
 - a. Living within the service area or the neighborhood of the project (defined below).
 - b. A YouthBuild participant.

Hiring is anticipated for the following trades:

Landscaping, Demolition, Saw-cutting, Concrete, General Laborer, Fencing.

Subcontracts may be let for the following categories of work on this project.
