



Notice Inviting Bids for the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District

Surface Water PFAS Removal Project No. 251

Notice is hereby given that the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District (District) will receive sealed bids for the Surface Water PFAS Removal Project (Project No. 3610005-001C) at its Engineering Department, located at 27307 State Highway 189, Blue Jay, CA 92317, until 2:00 PM on September 3, 2026. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time.

There will be a mandatory job walk at 10:00 AM on Thursday, August 6, 2026. All interested Contractors shall meet at the Cedar Glen Water Treatment Plant located at 201 Cumberland Drive, Cedar Glen, CA 92321.

The work consists of furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary to construct PFAS treatment facilities at the Bernina and Cedar Glen Water Treatment Plants. Including ion exchange treatment systems, piping modifications, pumps, filters, instrumentation, electrical improvements, testing, startup, commissioning, and all work required by specifications and construction drawings.

This project is subject to the payment of prevailing wages, Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) requirements, and all applicable federal funding requirements including; Build America, Buy America (BABA) provisions www.epa.gov/baba, Davis-Bacon Act Compliance www.waterboards.ca.gov/water_issues/programs/grants_loans/srf/davisbacon.html, and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements www.waterboards.ca.gov/water_issues/programs/grants_loans/srf/docs/policy0513/dbe_compliance_guidelines_instructions.pdf.
