Trinity River Authority of Texas for the Beneficial Use of Biogas RFP

In an effort to encourage participation of Historically Underutilized Businesses, (HUB), Trillium is soliciting qualified *Disadvantaged-Business-Enterprises* (DBE/MBE/WBE) for the beneficial use of biogas at the Central Regional Wastewater System Treatment Plant, located 600 Singleton Blvd., Grand Prairie, TX 75051

The Plant is in the commissioning phase of its Thermal Hydrolysis Process (THP) project which is anticipated to be completed by the end of 2023. To optimize energy production from the existing digesters at the Plant, we are looking for subcontractors to assist in the construction of this RNG facility.

Proposed scope is to build a biogas recovery and processing facility, including digester retrofits and improvements for maximizing biogas production and electrical power generation for Plant use or export to the grid.

Subcontractors needed for work relating to the following: NAICS Code: 237120 – Oil and Pipeline and Related Structures – This will include pumping stations and refineries, as well as natural gas processing plant construction. NAICS Code: 236220 Commercial and Institutional Building Construction. NAICS Code: 325120 Biogases, industrial (i.e., compressed, liquified, solid).
