

NOTICE INVITING BIDS

Pursuant to statute and to the authorization approved by the City of Simi Valley, California, and on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids for FY 2023-24 ANNUAL MINOR STREETS REHABILITATION PROGRAM, CDBG, CP60000019/CP60000032, Specification No. SV 24-03 will be received by the Deputy Administrative Services Director (Budget & Purchasing), at City Hall, 2929 Tapo Canyon Road, Simi Valley, California, 93063, at or before 3:00 p.m., on February 27, 2024, at which time they will be publicly opened and read at or about said hour and date by the City's Deputy Administrative Services Director (Budget & Purchasing) (or designated representative) at the above address.

This project is partially utilizing Community Development Block grant (CDBG) funds and is subject to all applicable State and Federal rules and regulations.

This is a HUD Section 3 covered construction contract. A Section 3 Pre-Bid Zoom meeting is scheduled to be held on Thursday, February 15, 2024, at 3:00 p.m. If you would like to be included, please email your contact information to Lien@simivalley.org.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project submitted on or after March 1, 2015, unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5, or unless the contractor or subcontractor qualifies for an exception from this requirement, for bid purposes only, as set forth in Labor Code section 1771.1(a). If contractor or subcontractor believes that such an exception in 1771.1(a) applies, it must provide the applicable exception(s) in its bid proposal. Even those contractors or subcontractors who qualify for an exception under 1771.1(a) must be registered with DIR at the time of award, if such award is made on or after April 1, 2015.

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project awarded on or after April 1, 2015 unless registered with DIR pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5, unless the small project exemption applies.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR.

SCOPE OF WORK:

Scope of Work Schedule I

The Minor Streets Rehabilitation Program Schedule I will consist of: 1) 139,235 S.F. of asphalt pavement cold milling; 2) 1,305 tons of asphalt placement; 3) 704 S.F. of sawcut, removal, and reconstruction of sidewalk; 4) 12 sawcut, removal, and reconstruction of curb ramps; 5) 1,005 S.F. of sawcut, removal, and reconstruction of concrete cross and/or longitudinal gutter; 6) 148 L.F. of concrete sidewalk grinding; 7) 77 L.F. of sawcut, removal, and reconstruction of concrete curb and gutter; 8) 12 sewer manhole frame and cover replacement; 9) traffic signing and pavement delineation; 10) construction surveying; and 11) all appurtenant work as provided in the Proposed Schedule of Work and Prices.

Scope of Work Schedule II

The Minor Streets Rehabilitation Program Schedule II will consist of: 1) 267,052 S.F. total of asphalt pavement cold milling; 2) 2,504 tons of asphalt placement; 3) 750 S.F. of sawcut, removal, and reconstruction of sidewalk; 4) 20 sawcut, removal, and reconstruction of curb ramps; 5) 90 S.F. of sawcut, removal, and reconstruction of concrete driveways; 6) 140 L.F. of concrete sidewalk grinding; 7) 79 L.F. of sawcut, removal, and reconstruction of concrete curb and gutter; 8) 15 sewer manhole frame and cover replacement; 9) 154,063 crack seal; 10) slurry seal; 11) traffic signing and pavement delineation; 12) construction surveying; and 13) all appurtenant work as provided in the Proposed Schedule of Work and Prices.

The specified completion time for time for Schedule I and II combined is 40 consecutive days after receipt of the Notice to Proceed.

The bid shall be balanced so that each bid item is priced to carry its share of the cost of the work and also its share of the contractor's overhead and profit. Schedule I & II combined shall be considered the "base contract" for purposes of awarding the contract. In accordance with Public Contract Code section 20103.8(a), the award of contract will be based on the lowest bid on Schedule I & II combined regardless of pricing of Schedules I and II individually. However, the City reserves the right to award or not to award.

All bids must be sealed and submitted at or before 3:00 p.m., on February 27, 2024. The Proposal shall be submitted and the work shall be performed by a State of California Class A licensed contractor in strict conformance with Specification No. SV 24-03, and now on file in the City's Department of Public Works and the Office of the City Clerk.

It is the bidder's responsibility to check the City's website for any addenda that may be issued for this project prior to submittal of the bid. Failure to submit required addenda with the bid disqualifies the bidder.

Copies of plans and specifications may be obtained by prospective bidders from the Department of Public Works at 2929 Tapo Canyon Road, Simi Valley, California 93063, upon the payment of \$30.00, plus \$10.00 for handling and mailing fees, if mailed. All prospective bidders shall abide by the provisions of the Bid Terms and Conditions listed in the project's specifications.

The City reserves the right to retain all proposals for a period of 60 days after the bid opening date for examination and comparison and to delete any portion of the work from the Contract.

The City reserves the right to determine and waive nonsubstantial irregularities in any proposal, to reject any or all proposals, to reject one part of a proposal and accept the other. The bid shall be balanced so that each bid item is priced to carry its share of the cost of the work and also its share of the contractor's overhead and profit. The City reserves the right to delete any bid item to the extent that the bid is qualified by specific limitation. An unbalanced bid shall be considered as grounds for rejecting the entire bid. The City further reserves the right to make award to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder as the interest of the City may require.

In accordance with the provisions of Division 2, Part 7, Chapter 1 of the California Labor Code, the California Department of Industrial Relations has established the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for each craft, classification, and type of work needed to execute contracts for public works and improvements. The per diem wages published at the date the Contract is advertised for bids shall be applicable. Copies of the prevailing rate of per diem wages are on file at the California Department of Industrial Relations and are available to any interested Party at www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD/index.htm. Future effective wage rates, which have been predetermined, are on file with the Department of Industrial Relations, and are referenced but not printed in said publication. The new wage rates shall become effective on the day following the expiration date and apply to this Contract in the same manner as if they had been included or referenced in this Contract.

Furthermore, the current Federal General Wage Determinations apply for this project as predetermined by the Secretary of Labor. If there is a difference in the Federal minimum wage rates and the California Department of Industrial Relations for similar classifications of labor, the contractor and its subcontractors shall pay not less than the higher wage rate.

The wage rate for any classification not listed by the Federal Department of Labor or the California Department of Industrial Relations, but which may be required to execute the Contract, shall be in accord with specified rates for similar or comparable classifications or for those performing similar or comparable duties, within the agencies' determinations.

The contractor may substitute securities for retention monies pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22300.
